The mega-fat "Mad Professor" single will be released in all record stores on April 20th, 1999. Don't sleep on this single, or I'll come over there and flick your nipples.

Check out ICP's new video "Another Love Song" on The Box. If you don't get The Box channel where you live then you probably get the bone. You won't be seeing ICP on MTV anytime soon. that contains a never before heard ICP song called "The Dirt Ball" featuring Twiztid. As for you Juggalo collectors out there, we need not tell you about the money things like this go for down the road. This marks ICP's first ever cover story for a major mag like Alternative Press. Juggalos! Get all 3 covers! The ICP 3 cover issue hit stands on May 4th, 1999.

ICP Action Figures. Well we've been hyping these fuckin' things for like 3 years I guess. Well they're finally here. Starting on May 21st go and get them bitches. J comes with a voodoo spear and Shaggy comes with an axe. Both J and Shaggy come in one package. They'll cost about \$25 bucks. But they're the shit. You can do whatever you want with them. Burn them, make them hump each other, stick them in your butt, whatever. You can lick their little plastic butts if you want to. We don't care. You can get them at any Camelot Music store or at Spencers Gifts in the mall. They're about 7 inches tall and detailed right down to the tattoos.

Both ICP and Twiztid come in the same box and there's even a limited edition set box that comes with ICP and Twiztid's manager Alex Abbiss too. That box is harder to find though. You'll have to hit an ICP concert or an instore for that one. The Beenie Boyz are the shit. They are also fully detailed sewn down to the tattoos. They won't be out until June though, but the regular ICP Action Figures hit all Camelot and Spencers gift stores this May. Remember if for some stale reason the Camelot or Spencers near you ain't got them, just tell 'em to fuck off. Bottom line is you can always get the action figures and both sets of Beenie Boyz at any ICP instore or at any ICP concert. That is your best place to find shit.

The entire album's music was written, produced, and engineered by Mike E. Clark as usual. So you know that it will have that same ruthless ICP flavor as always. Both versions of The Amazing Jeckel Brothers will be at every record store in the world

on May 25th. But if your city is fresh than there should besome stores selling at midnight on May 24th. By the way, if you look deep in the credits of Jake and Jack Jeckel, you find out how you can get a whole other ICP album that nobody in the world knows about... SHHHHHHHH!!! Check it out.

Starting May 25th (the day the new album comes out), ICP along with Psychopathic Records label mates and closest homies Twiztid and Blaze will climb inside of the new fire coated, crazy ass looking, Jeckel Brothers Tour Bus and launch a mega-large instore tour to meet all you Juggalos. ICP will set out coast to coast to meet you Juggalos face to face and in person. Here's how it will work. You'll go to the record store. You wait in line outside for a few hours kickin' it with other Juggalos like yourself. Then when you get up to the front, you'll go into the record store. There you'll see a big, dark, chamber thing set up inside of the store. This strange thing is called... The Psychopathic Asylum. The doctors will let you and your homies inside. Boom! Once inside, it's dark, loud, and foggy. To your left you'll see Blaze behind some glass. Blaze is Psychopathic Records newest find. His album will be out later this year. Then you'll turn the corner and you find Twiztid behind some glass as well. Then you'll walk around one last corner and there under the blue lights, lost in the fog

The Asylum was constructed by professional movie set builders and it takes a semi truck to haul it. The Psychopathic Asylum will travel the country greeting Juggalos from May 25th until July 1st. Oh yeah, every single person that goes through the Asylum and meets ICP will receive a brand new

Psychopathic Records Sampler. The sampler also contains a never heard before ICP song called "Sleep Walker." This sampler is free but the only way to get it is to get to the Asylum. Also each stop the Asylum makes will be a good place to find other rare merchandise and hard to find ICP shit. June 22nd, baby. ICP homies and Psychopathic label mates Twiztid are finally coming out correctly. Twiztid's full-length album "Mostasteless" contains 4 songs with ICP will be re-released this time, to record stores nationwide, June 22nd on Psychopathic/Island Records. Finally it will be out everywhere and easy to

find. If you already have the local version of Twiztid's album "Mostasteless," here's why you'll need to get the new version...

The whole album was re-mixed and hooked up by Mike E. Clark. Plus it also has 6 brand new songs that weren't on the local version as well as 3 more songs with ICP. Not to mention that the album was professionally mastered this time which means that its louder, clearer, and it thumps way harder than before. That means that it attacks your brain and stabs it way harder than the other cheap local version. Plus it has a new, fat ass cover illustrated by the folks at Chaos! Comics. Look for the new Twiztid video "How Does It Feel" on The Box channel in June, but just like ICP, don't expect any love from MTV. Twiztid helps ICP show the world that there are groups that don't need to follow the standard industry path to be heard. Twiztid and ICP both know that if you're a radio bitch boy, just a quick as the radio picked you up, they will drop you when the next big thing comes along. Fuck the radio, fuck MTV, and fuck everything that world has to offer. We'll stay underground. Just leave us the fuck alone as we rock shows, fuck hoes, and smoke those in this here Juggalo world forever. It will arrive in July.

Yes it's true. ICP has filmed a full length 90 minute motion picture. The movie is called "Big Money Hustlas" and it cost about 1,000,000 dollars of Polygram's money. The movie will be released straight to video in July. The film stars ICP and Twiztid along with co-stars Harland Williams (of Half Baked, Something About Mary, Dumb and Dumber, Rocket Man, etc.) The Jerky Boys, Fred Berry (Rerun), Jump Steady, Stefan Kudek, Mankind from the WWF, Rudy Ray Moore (Dolomite) and more. Themovie is a comedy and it's mad, mad, MAD fuckin' funny.

Shaggy plays Sugar Bear... a cop from San Francisco who is stuck in the 70's. He thinks he's Dolomite. Sugar Bear has cleaned up all the crime in Frisco so he heads east for tougher turf and he finds it in the Big Apple.

Violent J plays Big Baby Sweets... a mob boss who runs the streets of New York City. Twiztid play his two side kicks, Big Stank and Lil' Poot. Big Baby Sweets and his gang got the entire city of New York locked down.

Sugar Bear comes to New York and quickly discovers that Big Baby Sweets is the man behind most of New York's biggest crimes. They battle each other throughout the movie. It's the shit. You gotta see this crazy shit. The movie was going to be released to theaters in July, but ICP was against that. J and Shaggy feel that Big Money Hustlas is a film made for the Juggalos by Juggalos. If it were to hit theatres everywhere, thousands of people would go and

see it that ain't Juggalos and don't understand Juggalo humor... and therefore the movie would just get dissed. Everyone would say the movie sucked. Nobody would get it and it would be called a flop. ICP feels that in order to avoid all that bullshit, it's way better to just drop the movie straight to video and that way only ICP fans that want it will see it. This is our own Juggalo world so lets keep our movie in that world.

Big Money Hustlas will be out on video at all record stores and all video stores in July. There will be 2 big movie theater showings however, one will be in Detroit and one will be in New York. A theater in New York will host Polygram's premier party and a theater in Detroit will host ICP's premier party.

The other bands that might jump aboard the tour that we are talking with are Coal Chamber, Kool Keith, Vanilla Fuckin' Ice ... and possibly The Lords of Brooklyn. Its looking like Coal Chamber and Kool Keith will be the ones. That would be the nuclear bomb if that happens, but who knows? It seems like it changes every fuckin' day. Regardless ... you can bet that in July, you will see J and Shaggy take to the stage where they belong. Not in a movie or in a fuckin' wrestling ring, but ON STAGE. A smoky, sweaty, loud-ass, beer-smellin' club packed with psychopathic Juggalos screaming the words to serial killer music. ICP will return to that realm in July and they'll be ripping buildings in half with a sound system so loud that ninjas on Jupiter will tell us to turn it down. With stage

lights so bright that Stevie Wonder has to squint, and a stage so big that Yokozuna could do a ballet dance on that bitch if he wanted to. The Amazing Jeckel Brothers Tour will launch in July of 1999. Bet that.

ICP's long time homie Myzery has left Psychopathic Records, this time for good. We won't make no fuckin' lie about why, we will just flat out tell you the truth. Myzery does New York style hip-hop. ICP does something way, way

different. ICP and Myzery just could not see eye to eye on music. After two tours with ICP, Myzery has left the company to try different avenues. Psychopathic Records is an underground label that is gaining a big reputation for putting out bizarre and wild acts... Myzery is not that bizarre. Maybe a little wild, but not very bizarre. The two didn't fit. So ICP and Myzery set aside their personal feel-

roots. We'll miss Myzery and one thing that any Juggalo that has seen him live has to admit, "That ninja might not rap about choppin' heads off, but that kid can sure rock a fuckin' crowd!" Peace Myzery, we'll miss you ninja!

Twiztid's Jamie Maddrox and The Monoxide Child were both recently sentenced 8 months probation and a 500 dollar fine in a Detroit court room for a weed smoking charge. They'll have to take a piss test at random for the next 8 months and report to a probation officer once a month. This won't interfere with anything they have going on with Psychopathic Records. In fact, why arewe even telling you this? Fuck it, we're done. Who cares.

4. Available now... ICP's "Play With Me" Action Figures finally hit store shelves at all Camelot Stores and Spencers Gifts. They also will be sold at all ICP instores and concerts. From Yot Toys. Both figures come in one package for about \$25 bucks.

5. May 25th ... ICP's new album and 5th Jokers Card, The Amazing Jeckel Brothers, is released. There is 2 covers available to the same album. One is Jake Jeckel and the other is Jack Jeckel. Both will be on cassette or CD worldwide.

6. May 25th until July 1st... The Psychopathic

6. May 25th until July 1st... The Psychopathic Asylum Instore Tour sets out to meet Juggalos in person from coast to coast. All that attend the instore will receive a free brand new sampler CD featuring a unreleased ICP song.

7. June 22nd... Twiztid's album "Mostasteless," gets re-released nationwide by Psychopathic/Island Records. The record has 6 new tracks and 3 new songs with ICP. It will be out on cassette and CD everywhere they sell good music.

8. July... ICP's movie, Big Money Hustlas, comes out on video everywhere. The movie features costars Harland Williams, Mankind, The Jerky Boys, Rudy Ray Moore, Stefan Kudek, and Jump Steady. The film is 90 minutes long.

9. July... ICP's ENOURMOUS Amazing Jeckel Brothers World Tour launches. ICP and Twiztid,

along with 1 or 2 more bands, will destroy each and every city they play. 3 semis and 3 busses worth of show comes to every major city in the U.S.


